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“Extraordinary Meridians” and Cardinal Points – Part 1

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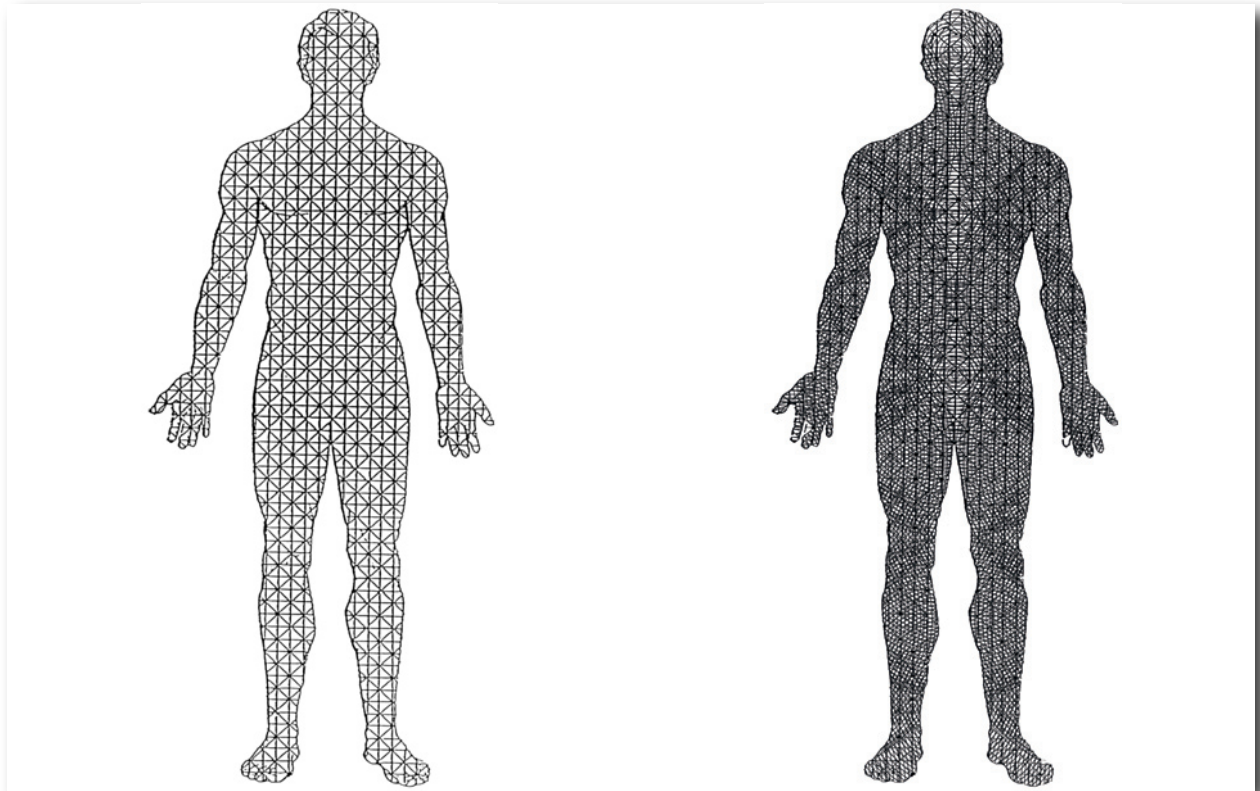
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In this and the following Esogetic Letters, I would like to focus on the “extraordinary meridians” and, in particular, the eight cardinal points. The overarching effect of these points has been known for a long time, and even those, who have no special training in acupuncture can use them effectively in their daily work with patients.

To begin with, let's take a brief look at the envelope surrounding our body.



The surface of our body displays a remarkable hologram containing all possible reflex areas.

Within this hologram, there are numerous points and zones that can help us to counteract the equally extensive imbalances present in each individual. This includes the entire system of acupuncture, but also all the segments and newly discovered points and zones that so many authors have passed on to us.

It also includes the treatment options established by Esogetic Medicine, which we have derived from Energetic Emission Analysis (EEA) or iris diagnosis.

From the wide range of possibilities, I have chosen the focus on and treatment of the opening points of the extraordinary meridians. The following is an introduction to this topic.

There are eight extraordinary meridians, each of which is assigned an opening point. These vessels are said to have four yang and four yin qualities, which in principle are not meridians. According to Dr. Gerhard Bachmann, the assigned opening points are among the most important of all acupuncture points. The eight opening points are located in the wrist and



ankle areas and are easy to find. The rule of thumb is that these opening points are used especially for chronic conditions. Bachmann assumes that there is a so-called "meridian failure." In this case, the points located on the respective meridian no longer respond to their assigned indications. To reactivate them, acupuncture uses the 8 extraordinary vessels and especially the opening points. Anyone who wants to learn more about the complicated treatment method of these extraordinary vessels and their application should consult the relevant literature (for instance the book "Akupunktur – eine Ordnungstherapie" [Acupuncture – A Regulation Therapy] by Dr. Gerhard Bachmann).

I am particularly curious about the opening points of the extraordinary vessels. In my therapeutic considerations I am assuming that the information-energy principle flows in the acupuncture meridians and that blockages in the respective meridians can trigger diseases.

First, an overview of the paired extraordinary vessels (Yin/Yang) and the corresponding opening points. I will provide both the Chinese names and Dr. Bachmann's translations.

1. **INN OE** = Vessel of the preserver (YIN) – Cardinal point P 6
2. **TSCHRONG MO** = Vessel of the disinhibitor (Yang) – SP 4
3. **IANG OE** = Vessel of the preserver (Yang) – TW 5
4. **TAE MO** = Belt vessel (Yin) – GB 41
5. **TOU MO** = Vessel of the ruler (Yin) – SI 3
6. **IANG TSIAO MO** = Vessel of the mover (Yang) – UB 62
7. **JENN MO** = Vessel of conception (Yang) – LU 7
8. **INN TSIAO MO** = Vessel of the mover (Yin) – K 3 according to Bachmann (in more recent literature also K 6 – see later).

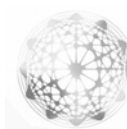
The indications and effects of the opening points are very extensive. I will therefore explain the connections when discussing the individual points.

Treatment is performed by induction or by combining point induction and colorpuncture at the opening points.

For all those, who practice acupuncture, acusiniatry, which has been passed on to us by Dr. Roger de la Fuye, is also an excellent option. I had the privilege of learning from Dr. Herbert Schmitt in Stuttgart, who in turn was a student of Dr. Roger de la Fuye. When applying acusiniatry, we combine it with colorpuncture. I will go into more detail when describing the individual points.

It is also possible to generate an "information wake-up call" from the wide range of induction programs available in conjunction with the opening points. We use the Gamma short and the PowerNap program for the individual opening points, and the Point-Combi and Point-Gamma programs for the paired opening points.

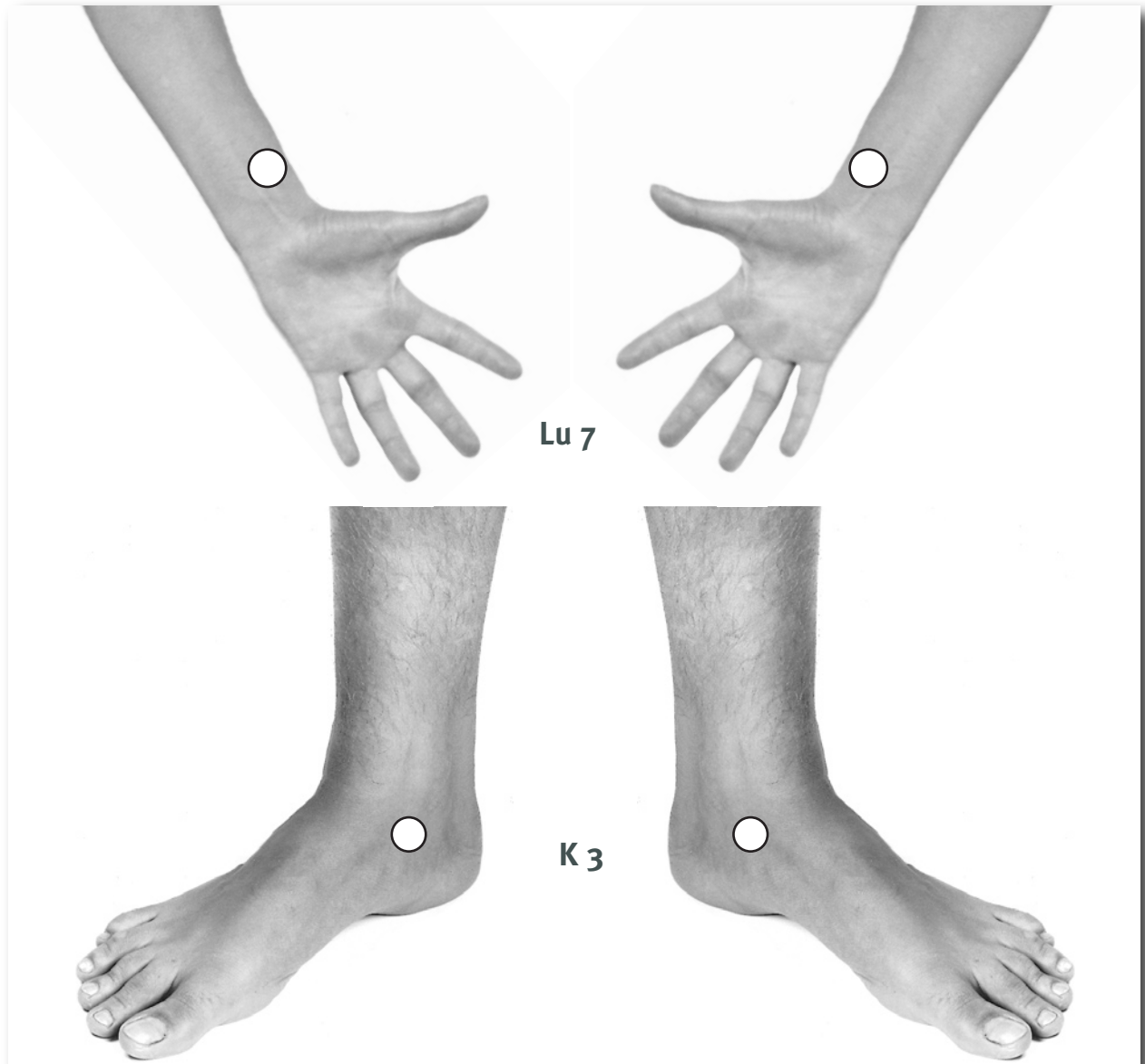
By applying the induction programs to the opening points, we have been increasingly observing that consecutive therapies work much better and, above all, faster.



Here is an example to illustrate this.

You can treat a pair of points based on the indication, or you can treat the points that are linked to each other. Here, LU 7 and K 3.

**INDUCTION OF THE MATCHING PAIRS OF POINTS
EXAMPLE: LUNG 7 UND KIDNEY 3 ACCORDING TO BACHMANN**



Let's first have a look at the general indications for the points:

INDICATION LU 7

- Lungs, bronchial disorders
- Drainage disorders - esp. focal, which means sinuses, teeth
- Mucous membrane disorders, especially in the head and intestines
- Polyp formation
- Lower abdominal stress
- Diabetes
- Skin, especially eczema

INDICATION K 3 (ALSO K 6 IN MORE RECENT LITERATURE)

- Nephritis, prostatitis, ovarian inflammation, impotence, orchitis,
- Intestinal intoxication and its consequences
- General constipation
- Bladder spasms
- Dysmenorrhea,
- General malaise
- Congestion in the lower pelvis
- Chronic laryngitis

K 3 (Bachmann) is located about two fingerwidths below the tip of the ankle, vertically downward.

Here is a case history for the points LU 7 and K 3

The corresponding opening points should be used therapeutically if, on one hand, the phenomenology in the EEA image does not change and, on the other hand, the symptom picture indicates both opening points. In this context, I would like to consider the opening points LU 7 and K 3 as a pair and show the EEA images of a patient with corresponding complaints.

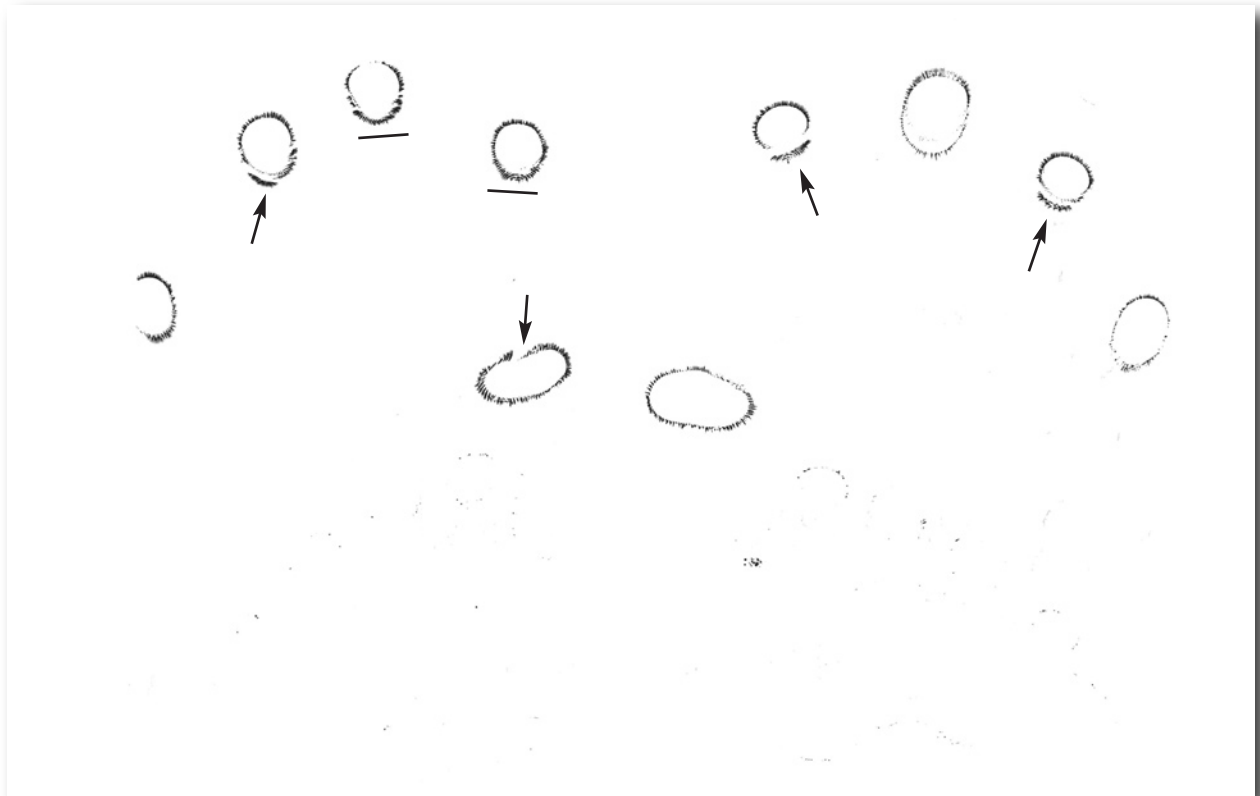


CASE HISTORY: 76-YEAR-OLD MALE PATIENT

He has been complaining of micturition and pain in the lower abdomen for a long time. Polyneuropathy, numbness, and pain in the feet.

General weakness, irregular sleep patterns due to frequent urination at night.

EEA IMAGE 1

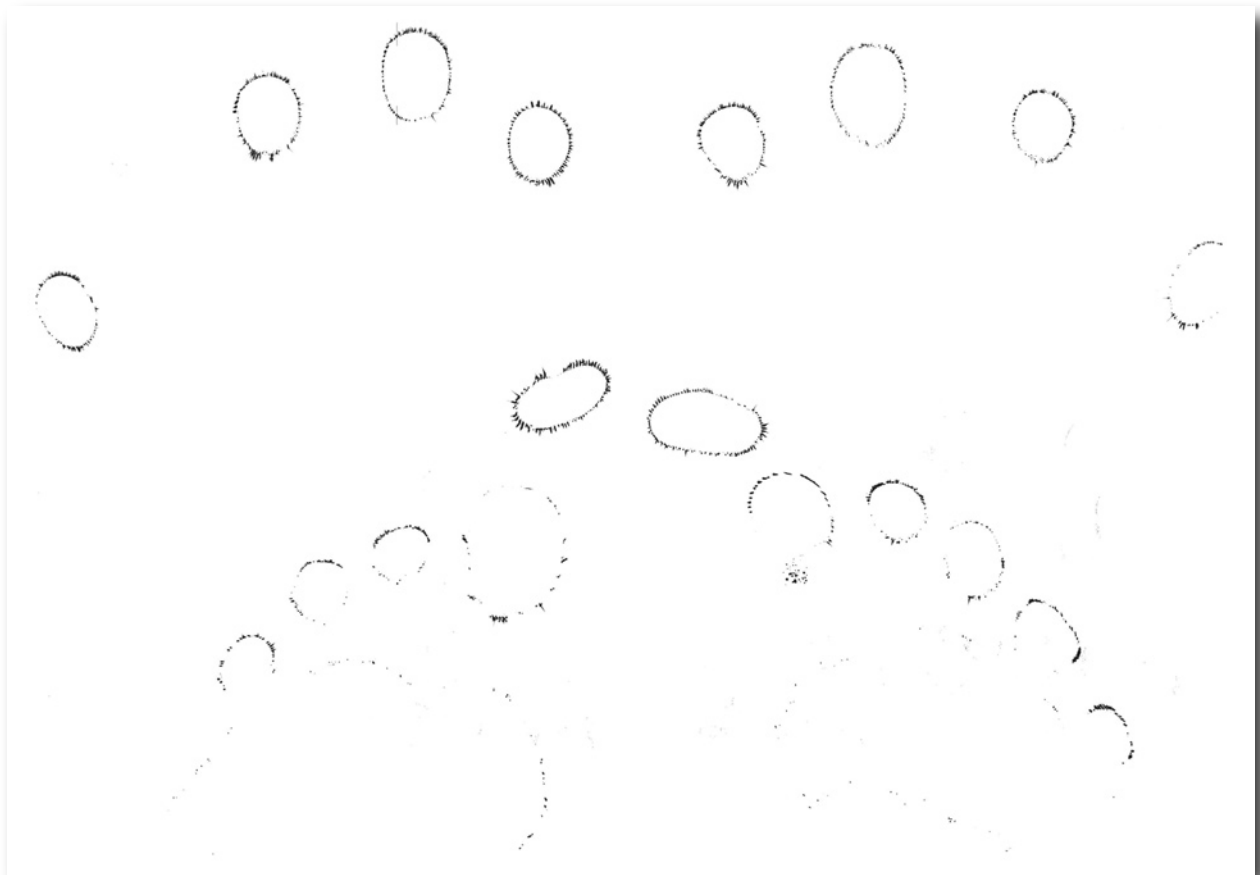


The EEA image confirms the patient's symptoms. Detachment signs in the pelvis on the right and especially in the prostate area on the right and left. The emissions shows minor degeneration. The maxillary sinus phenomena are also important, especially on the left, as they not only indicate lymphatic congestion in the head, but also point to the genital organs (sexuality). Taken together, these phenomena and especially the patient's symptoms are assigned to the opening points LU 7 and K 3.

We used the adapter to connect the four points and applied the Point Combination Program. During the treatment, the patient reported a strong warmth throughout the pelvis and especially in the head area, which he described as very pleasant. This reaction shows that the selection of points is also correct in relation to the phenomena of the EEA image.

The control image now shows the effects.



EEA IMAGE 2 – CONTROL IMAGE

The small degeneration remains, but all the detachment phenomena that had previously been dominant have disappeared. The foot emissions are visible again. Here, attention must now be paid to the polarity disturbance of both big toes (here the liver area). The signs of the maxillary sinuses are weaker, but still clearly visible. The insufficiency of both middle fingers indicates nervous overload in the patient (Mercury – Uranus). Overall, however, this is a very good response to this simple therapeutic approach, and further selections can be made from our pool of available remedies.

The focus lies on treating the maxillary sinuses (lymphatic system as a whole), balancing the polarity of both big toes, and balancing the specific laterality – in this case, Sun, Mars, Saturn, and Neptune. In relation to the hypertrophy of the prostate, the Bay li treatment would be included together with the kidney and urinary bladder segments.

In the next Esogetic Letter, I will describe the four pairs of points and show how they may be used.
